## Decision

Shri E. Premchand Singh represents as SPIO/Home. Shri S. Amirlal Sharma represents as ASPIO/Police Department. The Appellant is also present.

This is in continuation of hearing dt.28-10-15. In response to the direction of the Commission in its previous hearing the ASPIO/Manipur Police Department furnished a written statement related to FIR No: 222 (9) 2011 TBL PS u/s 364/302/341PC. The Commission is of the view that this is a verifiable proof of a case of acquittal related to human right violation.

The Commission is aware that the Manipur Police Department is exempted from the purview of the RTI Act, 2005 as per State Government notification No: 11/4/2005 – AR dt.15-10-2005 and 25-10-2005. However, the RTI application relates to matter concerning violation of human rights, the Commission directs the SPIO/Home Department to provide the information sought by the appellant free of charge within 45 (forty five) days from the date of receipt of this order.

With this direction, the appeal case is closed.
