DECISION

The SPIO/ Director (YAS) is represented by Ms. L. Anita Chanu, Assistant Director (YAS), Manipur and Shri N. Parithoihen Meitei, Senior Finance Officer, (YAS), Manipur. The Appellant is present along with Md. Parvez Shah through an authorization letter.

In compliance of the Commission's Order dated 27.5.2025, the Public Authority placed an Authorization letter issued by the Director (YAS), Manipur before the Commission.

During the hearing, the representative of the Public Authority (YAS) submitted a letter dated 16.6.2025 to the Commission and clarified that there was a typographical error in the earlier information given to the Appellant. She further submitted that word "Commandant" of room No. 43 of the Khuman Lampak, Main Stadium should be read as "Commander". She also handed over a similar copy of the said letter to the Appellant and further stated that all the query wise information had already been provided to the Appellant after conducting joint survey on 16.5.2025 at 2 pm in the presence of the Director (YAS) and his subordinate staff.

In response, the Appellant prayed the Commission for checking the information provided by the Public Authority for every query as reflected in the RTI application.

On checking the query wise information with the Appellant, the Commission finds that there are rooms in 31 rooms in hockey stadium and 43 rooms in main stadium. However, the Appellant did not sought information about the total number of the rooms in the main stadium. In the meantime the Public Authority once again clarified that the Directorate of YAS has not issued any Official Orders regarding allotment of rooms to any of its employees however, one Shri W. Nabachandra Singh, Chowkidar of the Hockey Stadium is currently occupying two rooms at the Hockey Stadium and it is an internal arrangement of the Department and no Orders have been issued in this connection. The rooms of the said Hockey Stadium are utilized for storing equipment, changing room for the coaches and players, keeping water pumps, electric items and urgent activities etc. but, no income were generated from these rooms, she added.

After getting the clarification from the Public Authority, the Appellant raised no additional contentions on the subject of request. He also agrees to close the present Appeal case.

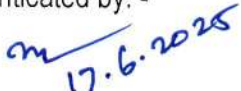


As the Appellant is satisfied with information/ reply from the Public Authority, no further proceedings is called for.
